Peter N. DiCenzo, age 89, formerly of Girard, passed away peacefully late Friday afternoon, Oct. 30, 2015, at Hoosier Christian Village in Brownstown.

Peter was born January 13, 1926, in Youngstown, a son of the late Cesare and Viola DeGennaro DiCenzo, and lived in Girard for most of his life.

He was a 1944 graduate of Girard High School and was a U.S. Army veteran, serving for 18 months just after the end of World War II.

Mr. DiCenzo was a machinist for Commercial Intertech for 43 years, and belonged to the Tool & Die Makers Union.
