Randall E. "Randy" Miser, age 75, Bloomington, formerly of Medora, passed away at noon Thursday, May 2, 2013, at IU Health, Bloomington.

Randy was a retired bailiff with Jackson Circuit Court, past Jackson County commissioner, assessor and Jackson County chairman of the Democrat Party. He owned and operated Randy's Market for more than 20 years in Medora. He was a 50-year member of Medora Masonic Lodge 328, member of the Jackson County Fair Board and the Jackson County Detention Center Board.
